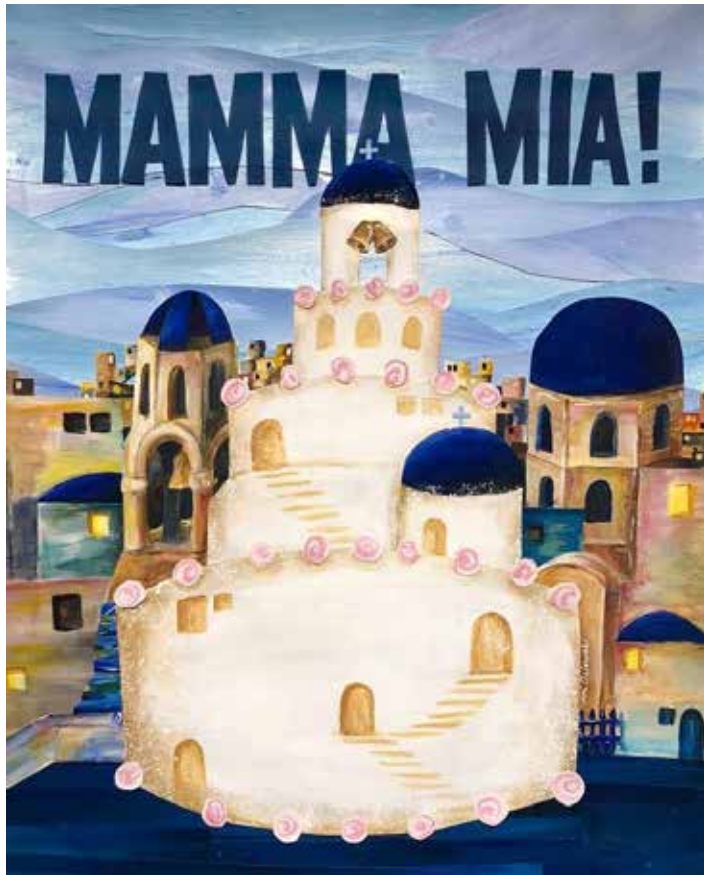


## TAKE A CHANCE ON MIA!

## LOCAL VOCALS

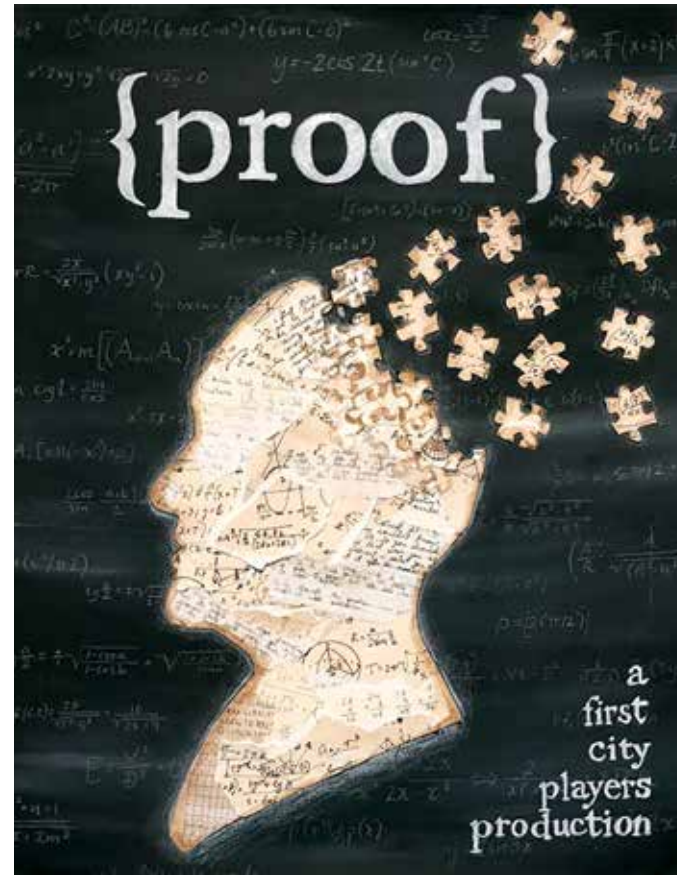


Professional musicians train and accompany talented Ketchikan folks for gala evenings of cabaret. These polished performances follow two weeks of collaboration in a workshop setting.

## THE AFTERMATH

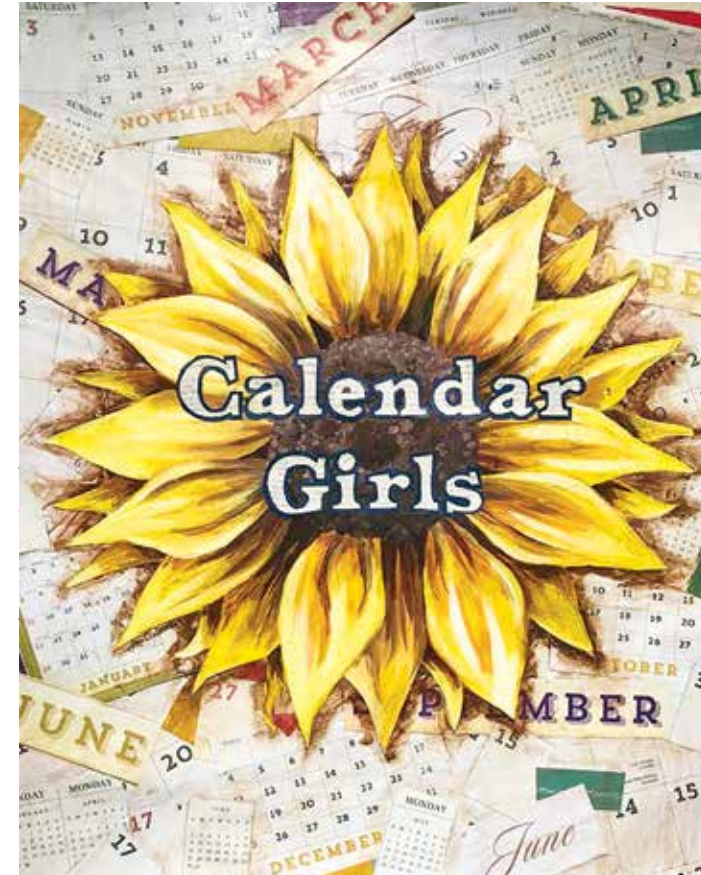

## BROTHELIZER

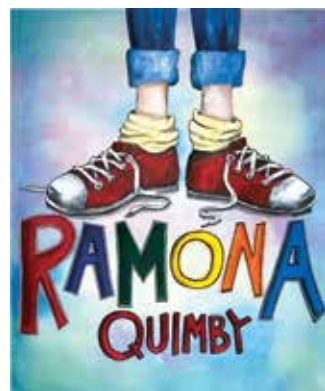

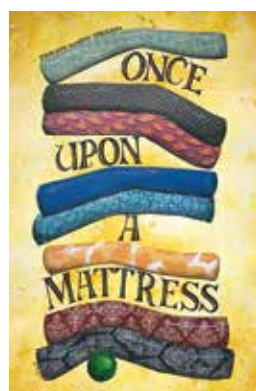
